Information for EYFS Parents for September 2020

August 24th 2020

Northstead School welcomes our EYFS children for small transition sessions from Tuesday 8th September 2020. You should have received an email detailing the session dates and times.

Organisation of school

In order to meet all our children and parents safely, EYFS children will not start full time until week three.

Class groups will be our Class 'Bubbles'. These will be up to 30 children in one EYFS class.

Whenever possible these class groups will be kept apart but there may be occasions when they form Year Group 'Bubbles'.

Face coverings – these may be worn by parents and children on the way to and from school. Children must remove face coverings before entering school – these may be given to the parent or kept in a sealed plastic bag.

Children will wash their hands on entry to school and frequently throughout the day.

Children are not allowed to bring in items from home.

Cleaning will take place during the day to minimise the risk of using shared items.

All children will need to bring a water bottle to school every day.

The School Day

The start of the day – from Monday 21st September

Only one parent/adult per child will be allowed on the school grounds.

The school day starts at 8.45 a.m. with gates and doors open from 8.30 a.m. Parents bringing children to school should maintain a safe distance on the approach to school and whilst on the premises.

From Monday 21st September, EYFS will enter via the EYFS/KS1 pathway, next to the dining room, drop their child at the EYFS entrance then follow the one-way system and leave via the main carpark.

EYFS staff will be on the doors to greet your child and welcome them into the building. We will be able to discuss this transition with parents during their short sessions during the first two weeks.

The end of the day

There will be a staggered end of the day as follows. These will be the timings for the first half term.

Timings will change after half term.

Please arrive promptly at the correct time to collect your child so that we can leave the school safely.

EYHJ end 2.45 p.m.

EYRR end 2.50 p.m.

EYSS end 2.55 p.m.

Parents enter via EYFS/KS1 gate, collect child and exit via carpark.

Parents with siblings will be allowed to wait on the yard, please maintain a safe distance at all times.

Lunch times

EYFS will have hot dinner in dining room at 11.30am. Full menu will be available (menu will be given during your first session so that parents can then order dinners for the rest of the term) All EYFS children are eligible for Universal Free School Meals. Please let us know of any dietary requirements.



Wrap around care - The Jungle Club

This is based in the school dining room.

Before School

Open from 7.50 a.m. – 8.30 a.m. Access via the EYFS/KS1 pathway and new Dining Room doors. Children will be kept in year group bubbles as far as possible.

After school

Open from 2.45 p.m. – 5.30 p.m. Children will be kept in year groups as far as possible. Children will be collected by one parent from the dining room doors via the KS1 entrance.

End of school day – 4.15 p.m. £3.50 per session. Must be booked in advance

School Uniform

Boys:

- Grey/Black Trousers/Shorts
- Grey Jumper
- Grey/White Socks
- White Shirt with tie **or** white polo shirt (without tie)
- Black Shoes
- Ties will be available to buy during transition sessions.

Girls:

- Grey/Black Skirt/Pinafore/Trousers
- Grey Jumper/Cardigan
- White/Grey/Black Socks or Tights
- White Blouse/White Shirt with tie **or** white polo shirt (without tie)
- Black shoes
- Ties will be available to buy during transition sessions.

Please ensure that all uniform is clearly named.

No trainers are permitted.

Uniform items can be purchased from most high street retailers.

A navy blue fleece with a Northstead School logo is available from “Rumours”. It is for use as a jacket, not to be worn in the classroom – Rumours are asking families to make appointments.

We look forward to your continued co-operation in helping to make our children smart, well presented members of the school and wider community.

PE Kit

PE kit will not be required for the EYFS year.

Parents in school

No parents are allowed in school without an appointment. If you need to make an appointment please ring the school office or contact by email. If this is not possible, please go to the main entrance and use the new video call system to speak to a member of staff.

Bikes and Scooters

No bikes or scooters are allowed on the school grounds until further notice.
