

A few key priorities for next week for all adults on our premises to follow:

- You must wear a mask when on the school site unless medically exempt.
- Respect staff safety and always stay at a distance of 2m or more from them.
- Do not enter the school building at any time unless invited to do so. This also applies to the reception area. (Please ring the buzzer and a staff member will come to see you).
- You do not need to arrive on the school site before your child's allocated pick up time. Please follow the rule of WALK IN, PICK UP, WALK OUT.
- If waiting for siblings, please ensure you keep socially distant from other parents and your children always stay with you.
- School gates open at 8:30am and close at 8:45am. You should arrive to school between these times. If your child walks to school by themselves, please ensure they are also not arriving to school before 8:30am.

Do not allow your children to play on any equipment in any of the playgrounds when leaving school or when waiting.

Whilst school will be open to all children from Monday, the country remains in a national lockdown.

Please follow the points above to ensure the safety of all children, families and staff of our school.
