Instrumental Lessons

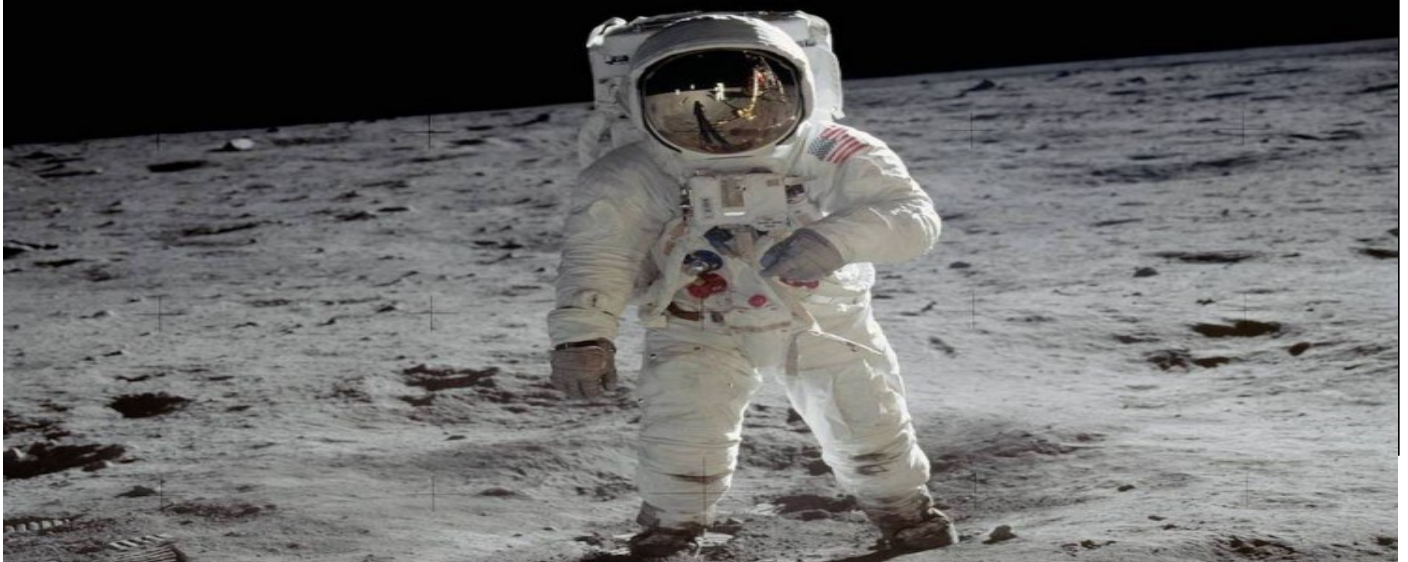

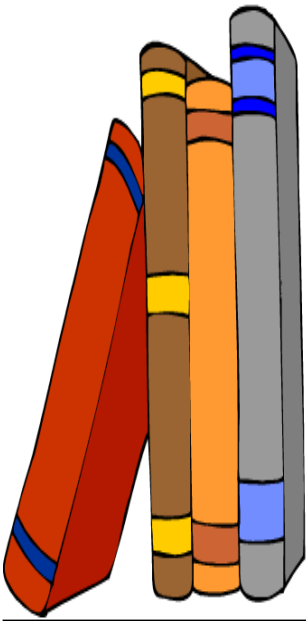
The Moon and Space

National Literacy Trust to promote reading.

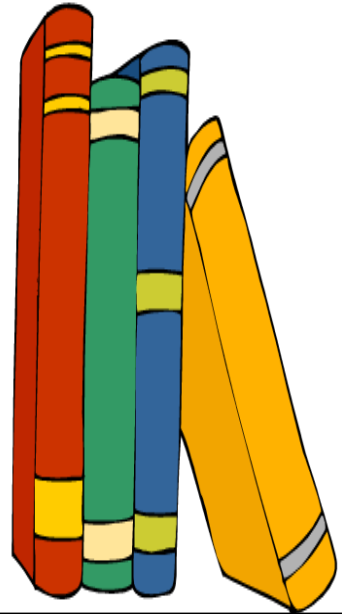


Love our Libraries
