Payment for school dinners **MUST be made in advance of meals taken** on Monday of that week. School dinners are £2.20 a day, £11.00 per week. Payment is preferred by ParentPay, our secure online payment system. If you don't have your login details please contact the school office. If you are sending cash, please do so in a named sealed envelope.

We would like to thank the majority of our parents who do pay promptly for their children's meals, and ask that you take a moment to check your ParentPay balance to ensure this is in credit.
