## Punctuality

Can we please remind parents of the need to ensure that all children arrive at school on time. The school day begins at 8:45am, and children should arrive any time after 8:30am. Children who arrive after 8:45am will automatically receive a late mark.

#### **Illness and Absence**

Please telephone the school before 8:45am on the first morning of absence, indicating the reason for absence and the likely length of absence. We ask that you keep us informed about your child's illness if they are off for longer than a couple of days.

It is school policy that any child with a sickness bug should remain off school for 48 hours after their last dose of sickness to avoid the spread of infection.

# Latest COVID19 Guidance for Parents and Families

As you are aware the latest guidance on Covid has changed. If a child has any Covid symptoms they must not attend school and must take a Lateral Flow Test. If this is negative then they can return to school. If it is positive then they must get a PCR Test within 2 days and stay at home until the result is known. If this is positive then they must self-isolate for 10 days, but their close contacts do not need to do so if they are either;

- Under 18 years
- Are double vaccinated
- Are part of an approved COVID 19 vaccine trial
- Not vaccinated due to medical reasons

If there are any changes to this guidance, we will let you know as soon as possible.

School staff are not allowed to remove or replace earrings.




