Some children are trying to play 'Red light, green light' at lunch times on the playground and mimic different parts of the show. There have been several stories in the news this week about the dangers of recreating some of the games.

Since Squid Game is rated age 15, it is not an appropriate topic for any of our children to be talking about in school. We have spoken to all of our Key Stage 2 children about this, to remind them of the dangers of accessing age inappropriate material.
