

Coats / Hats / Gloves

During this term, the weather continues to be cold and wet, and sometimes icy. As much as possible, the children will go outside at playtimes. Please ensure your child has the appropriate clothing items, including a warm winter coat, hat, gloves and waterproof shoes.



Punctuality



All children are expected to be in their classrooms for 8:45, the official start time for the day. If your child enters school via the main front door, they are recorded as late and will receive a late mark, which requires a reason for lateness. Please make sure your children are punctual and on time for school.

Entry to school in the mornings

Please remember that we operate a one way system arriving into school via the Key Stage 1 playground in the mornings. Parents and carers are asked NOT to bring their children into school via the staff car park - this is used to exit the school playground only.

Water Bottles

Some children have brought 'Prime' water bottles into school this week. These are causing issues. These water bottles should not be brought into school and are not allowed. Can we please remind you that children should use Northstead water bottles, which are available from the office for £1.60. Your child may bring a different non-branded water bottle if they have lost / damaged their Northstead bottle. Children should bring a bottle to school every day with fresh, clean water.

Please can we also remind you that children should have clear water in their transparent bottles, as we encourage children to drink water, rather than juice.
