Literacy	As readers, we will be working on non-fiction texts about famous explorers and fantasy stories set in space
	As creative writers, we will be writing recounts and letters, about real events and using our imagination to write fictional space stories.
Maths	As marvellous mathematicians, we will be beginning our learning with shape and moving onto money, then multiplication and division.
Science	As scientists, we will be learning about animals including humans and the importance of being healthy.
DT	As design technicians we will be using our chef skills to create a healthy snack.
Art	As artists we will be exploring a printing pathway 'Exploring the world through Mono-print'
History	As Historians, we will be learning about famous explorers, using chronology and timelines.
RE	The first half term we will be continuing our learning about Judaism and Shabbat. The second half term focuses on Christianity with lent and Easter.
PSHE	The first half term our Jigsaw topic will be 'Dreams and Goals' – The second half term is 'Healthy Me' please see the attached documents.
Music	As Musicians we will be learning Rock and Reggae through our Charanga programme
Computing	As computer technicians we will be following the 'We are Astronauts' programme of study, learning how to programme a character through the 'scratch' software.
PE	As sports personalities we will be starting our term with indoor dance and outdoor ball skills.
